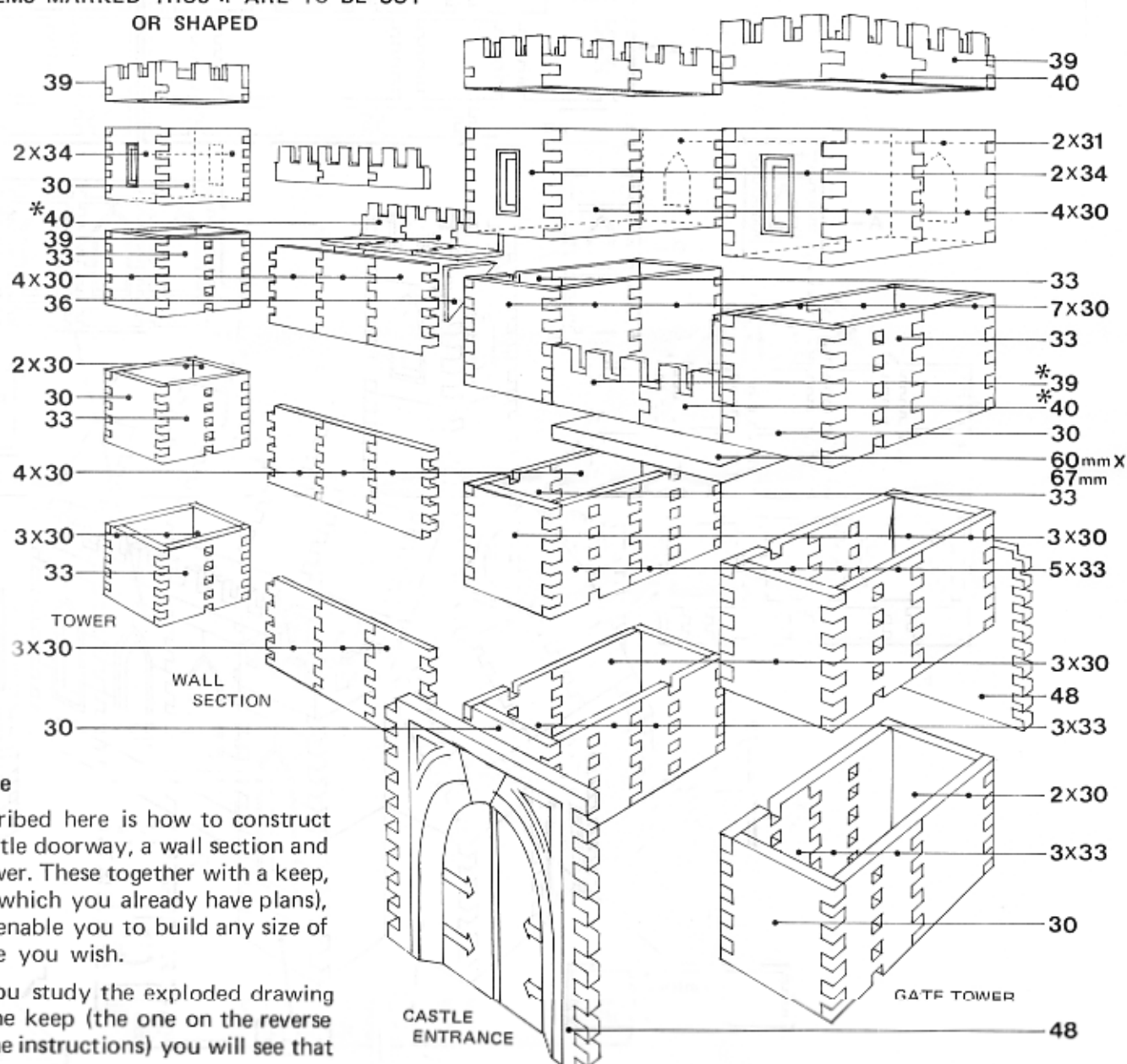

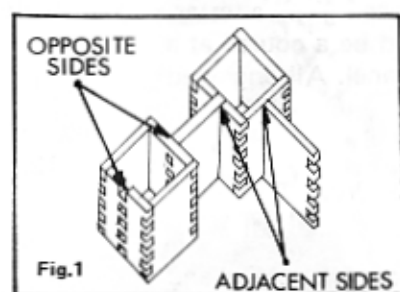

Castle

Described here is how to construct a castle doorway, a wall section and a tower. These together with a keep, (for which you already have plans), will enable you to build any size of castle you wish.

If you study the exploded drawing of the keep (the one on the reverse of the instructions) you will see that each side has provision made for attaching a wall section. By linking together a doorway, a keep, towers and wall sections you can build a castle to any design you wish.



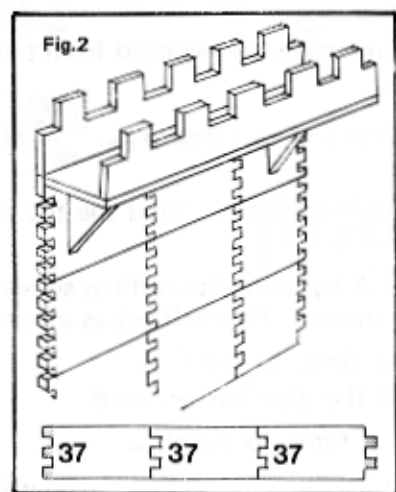
Tower

The construction of a basic tower is shown. See Fig. 1. A point you must note is that for a tower which is in a straight section of wall the linkage castings number 33 are on opposite sides. When the tower is on a corner the linkage castings number 33 must be on adjacent sides.

Wall Section

The construction of a wall section is shown. Fig. 2.

This wall section can be as long as required. Do not build the section then try to link it to a tower. It is better to build and fit one course at a time.



Castle Entrance

1. Construct the rectangular sections which make up the gate towers. Note carefully how castings number 33 are positioned.
2. Glue two large doorways between the gate towers. Note that these doorways should face outwards.
3. Glue in place the next sections to link into the doorways.
4. Cast a panel 60mm x 67mm and glue this in place over the doorways level with the front and back corners of the towers.
5. Glue the remaining sections in place then glue castings 39 and 40 around the top of each tower. Castings 39 and 40 should also be glued to the front and back edges of the platform above the doorways.
